The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a rear kitchen. 2/2 sash windows light the dwelling. The structure is covered with lapped wooden siding and has decorative "fish scale" shingles in the gables. The main entrance is centered in the east bay of the front elevation.

The house faces north onto Huntingtown Road. It is a two-story, single-pile, framed and weatherboarded house with a side-passage-parlor plan. It has a three-bay facade. The doorway is sidelighted and transomed, and the sash are two-over-one. There is an interior brick chimney set along the rear wall. The rear two-story ell is probably original. The gable roof is covered with asphalt shingles. It is distinguished by a front-facing wide gable filled with scalloped wood shingles. A one-story hipped-roof screened-in porch has turned posts and sawn brackets. One-story wings, masked by the porch, are additions.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame house measures three bays wide by one bay deep. A prominent cross-gable distinguishes the facade. The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a rear kitchen. 2/2 sash windows light the dwelling.

The structure is covered with lapped wooden siding and has decorative "fish scale" shingles in the gables. The cornice moldings and frieze continue across the gables and suggest pent roofs or pediments. The main entrance is located in the east end bay of the front or north elevation. There are only two bays at the first story, the door and a double window to its west. There is a partially enclosed wrap around porch which is supported with turned posts decorated with scroll cut brackets. A brick chimney is located inside the west end wall.





LOWER MARLBORO 4.0 MI. ↑


