This house is located far back off Huntingtown Road. It faces south. It is a framed and weatherboarded one-story T-plan with an early or original ell. There is a front-facing gable set into the roof near the southeast corner of the house, on the end opposite the cross of the T. There are two original interior brick stove flues. The original house dates from about 1900, but a heavy-handed renovation was begun during the 1960s or 1970s. The exterior walls were stuccoed over, all windows and doors were changed, new wide board siding was put into the gable ends, and the roof was freshly shingled. Before the work was complete, the house was abandoned.




