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DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The north-facing barn includes a southern shed. The north wall features a pair of batten doors hung on pintle hinges.

This wall is sheathed in riven clapboards, c.4' long. The ends and top edges of the clapboards are feather-edged and lapped. Other sides are covered with vertical boards. The eaves construction includes a thick flat false plate.

Corrugated metal sheets cover the roof. The barn stands on concrete piers.




