## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The gable-roofed east-facing frame church is augmented by a gabled addition extending to the north. The palladian-shaped entrance comprises columns in antis and a set of double doors topped by a semi-circular stained-glass transom. A bell tower rises from the vestibule. Patterned shingles, dentils, an open belfry, and a polygonal spire highlight the tower.

Stained glass windows light the German-sided church. It rests on a rusticated concrete-block foundation. The exposed rafter feet are cut in a decorative curve.



LOWER MARLBORO 4.0 MI.


