DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame house measures three bays wide by one bay deep. A prominent cross-gable distinguishes the facade. The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a rear kitchen section. 1/1 sash windows light the dwelling.

The north facade's porch has been enclosed. This side's cross-gable is unfenestrated. Interior brick stove-flue chimneys heat the east end of the main block and the south end of the two-story ell. The house measures two bays deep rather than the usual single bay for this type.

A one-story kitchen extend south from the ell. A single dormer lights its eastern roof slope. A one-story addition covers the east side of both the ell and the kitchen.

The house stands on a cement-covered foundation. Patterned metal shingles cover its roof, and asbestos shingles cover the walls.

Several frame sheds exist on the property.


