DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame house measures three bays wide by one bay deep. A prominent cross-gable distinguishes the facade. The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a rear kitchen section. 6/6 sash windows light the dwelling.

The east facade's southern entrance and northern interior brick stove-flue chimney suggest a side-hall single-parlor plan. Another chimney heats the west end of the two-story, two-bay rear ell. The house stands on a concrete-covered foundation. Pressed metal shingles cover the roof, and asbestos shingles cover the walls. The gables retain attractive patterned shingles. The cross-gable features an arched window.


