DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This abandoned Victorian farmhousr faces the Patuxent River to the west. The two-story frame building measures three bays wide. A two story bay window extends from the south end, and a hip-roofed porch covers the facade and north end. A central cross-gable with an interior brick stove-flue chimney to either side, and a central entrance lend symmetry to the house. A kitchen ell extends to the rear of the building.

Sidelights and a transom light the entrance. One over one windows light the house. Turned posts and jigsaw brackets embellish the proch. Asphalt shingles cover the roof. The house stands on a brick foundation. German siding sheathes the walls.

The central stair hall is flanked by a parlor to either side. A square newel post and turned balusters join a closed-stringer board trimmed with parallel lines of molding.

A frame tobacco barn appears to the northeast, and a well to the south is covered by a small frame structure.


