DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame house is built in an L-shape, with one section projecting at the front. Each elevation of each section consists of a single bay. A one-story porch fills in the "L" at the facade. A kitchen addition completes the plan. All sections are covered with gable roofs.

Two interior brick chimneys heat the house - one in the center of the main block and one at the south end of the rear two-story kitchen ell. The house stands on a concrete-covered foundation.

A log shed stands c. 100 yards south of the dwelling. The one-story building's gable roof runs north-south. The entrance appears in the south end. Horizontal weatherboards sheathe the south gable. Vertical boards cover the exterior walls. One exposed corner displays shallow v-notching. Corrugated metal covers the roof. Remnants of whitewash remain under the eaves.

Several late-19th century and early 20th century frame tobacco barns stand south of the shed.


