DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This plain frame house measures three bays long by one bay deep. The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a kitchen section. The dwelling stands two stories tall.

A cross-gable lit by an arched window appears at the south facade's east end. This side's central door is surrounded by sidelights and a transom. Jigsaw scrollwork brackets and turned posts distinguish the porch.

Two over two sash windows framed in plain flat boards light the house. Metal shingles cover the roof and asbestos shingles protect the walls. The original German siding is visible under the porch. A combination brick and stone foundation supports the house.
