This two-story frame house measures five bays wide by two bays deep. A gable roof covers the building. An extensive porch shelters the facade. A rear kitchen addition extends the house.

Two over two sash windows light the house. A central entrance appears in the west facade. The first-floor windows to the right are smaller and more closely spaced than the others. A single window is centered in the second story above these two.

Standing-seam metal covers the roof. Asphalt imitation brick sheathing covers the walls.



300,000 FT


Joins Map 7
