The building's half-story is lit by nine-pane single casement windows.

A shed-roofed porch covers the facade. A later kitchen is attached to the north end. The asphalt roofed house stands on a brick foundation. A combination of straight-sawn and circular-sawn materials were used to construct the building.






Broomes Island Quadrangle
