A porch wraps around all sides but the west. The south facing house is lit by two over two sash windows.

"Beavertail" metal shingles cover the roof. Narrow lapped weatherboards sheath the walls.

A one story kitchen stands about 8' east of the house. The kitchen predates the main house in style. A gabled frame outbuilding appears east of the house.


