### **SUMMARY**

The McKittrich property was originally surveyed in 1979. During a field survey of Dunn Road in 2009 the Lawrence M. McKittrich Farmhouse could not be located. The farm is currently owned by Rudolph and Marianne Reichel, who enrolled in the Calvert County Agricultural Preservation District program in 1989.<sup>1</sup> The original modest farm house, attributed to the McKittrich's, has been demolished. The property consists of 125 acres with 56 acres plowed for agricultural purposes; 19 acres of hay, 10 acres of rye, 10 acres of corn, and 19 cattle. The property is located immediately to the east of Suit's Chance (Tax Map 19 Parcel 31) where Dunn Road end at a private road.
