This two-story frame house measures three bays wide by one bay deep. A prominent cross-gable distinguishes the facade. The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a rear kitchen section.

Six over six sash windows framed in plain flat boards light the house. The south facade features a central entrance. Turned posts and decorative brackets distinguish the porch. A brick chimney heats either gable end.

A frame barn standing across the lane to the east includes sheds on at least three sides.




