This two-story frame house measures three bays wide by one bay deep. A prominent cross-gable distinguishes the facade. The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a rear kitchen section.

The north facade features a central entrance. A plain balustrade encloses the porch. The cross-gable is unfenestrated. A two-story bay window projects from the east end. An interior brick chimney heats the west end.

The two-story rear ell is joined by the three-bay-long kitchen set on concrete block piers.


