Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

The John J. Kelly Cross-Gable was previously surveyed in 1980 and 1986. A determination of eligibility was not provided during either survey of the property. Constructed circa 1900, this 2-story cross-gable vernacular farmhouse is a ubiquitous resource in the region and has been altered with window replacements and rear additions. A severely altered outbuilding is located west of the house. The historic acreage associated with this property has been subdivided and developed. The Prince Frederick Senior Village was constructed west of the house in 1986. In 1993, acreage to the east of the house was developed as the Silverwood Farm, a 180-unit garden-style apartment complex.

The property contained nearly 83 acres when purchased by Joseph Hall during the 1890s. Based upon architectural evidence, the house was constructed on the property circa 1900. Numerous pieces of the farm were sold during the early twentieth century that by 1914, when the farm was sold to Millard Cookeman Alton, the property contained 37.25 acres of land. Alton increased the size of the farm to 42 acres by 1936, when the property was sold to Duke and Zora Brightwell. The Brightwell's sold a 4.7 acre parcel of their farm for the establishment of the Old Calvert County Fairgrounds (CT-510) in 1941. John J. and Esther Kelly purchased the farmhouse and surrounding 33 acres in 1961. The Kelly family retained the property until 1987. The current owner, Raymond Fowler, purchased the house and 2 acres of land in 1993.

The property is recommended as not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. This vernacular house is ubiquitous


to the area and its agricultural association has been lost by subdivision and development. As such, the property does not represent an historic event or trend that made a significant contribution to the development of the nation, state, or local community, and therefore is not eligible under Criterion A. cursory historic research indicates that the property has no association with persons who have made specific contributions to history, and therefore, it does not meet Criterion B. It is not eligible under Criterion C as it is an indistinctive example of a common building type. The integrity of the structure has been compromised by window replacements and rear additions. Investigations have not been conducted to determine whether the property has the potential to yield information important in history or pre-history, therefore, National Register Criterion D can not be assessed at this time.

This house and its two-acre site is presently for sale.

It is a three-bay, framed and weatherboarded I-house. The gable roof has a front-facing cross gable over the central bay. The two brick stove flues are located on the interior of the gable-end walls. The two-story rear ell has an interior brick stove flue at the juncture of the two gable roofs. The ell is one bay long. The facade is sheltered by a one-story shed-roofed porch with turned posts and no other decoration. The original windows have two-over-two sash. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles and the original weatherboarding has been replaced with vinyl siding.














