According to information prepared by SHA, the Bernice Harrod House, located at 365 Tobacco Ridge Rd., Prince Frederick vicinity, does not meet any of the National Register Criteria for listing. The very small, two bay wide, one-and-one-half story log structure was probably constructed in the last quarter of the 19th century. A series of additions as well as alterations to the fenestration, window replacement and other unsympathetic alterations have all but obscured the original building. The Bernice Harrod House does not appear to embody the distinctive characteristics of a type, period or method of construction or possess high artistic value and has little integrity. Research in Calvert County historical records did not reveal any association with free blacks as suggested in the inventory form. The house is not located in any known historic district.

Late 19th Century

Freed slaves may have built this true 1½ story frame cabin. The gable-roofed rectangle runs two bays in either dimension. A stone-based exterior brick chimney heats the south end. Six-pane windows flanking the chimney stack light the left. A hip-roofed porch covers the east side's northern deer and southern 6/6 sash window. "German" siding sheathes this facade. Weatherbeaten lapped weatherboards cover the remainder of the house.

A shed-roofed addition, including a porch, covers the west side. Several sheds appear at this end of the house.





