Mid 19th Century

A tree-shaded hilltop provides the dramatic setting for this large frame house. Unusual placement of exterior features suggests several periods of architectural change before the house reached its present four-bay by two-bay, two-story form. This dwelling comprises a rear kitchen addition and a southeastern screened porch. On the main, or south, facade, the third bay from the left contains the transomed door. An oval window lights the stairwell in the second story above the door. Louvered shutters flank the 6/6 sash windows.

A single interior chimney stack rises from the south gable slope at the west end. One first floor window and two second-floor windows light this end.




