The several sections and cross-gables of this two-story frame house leave its evolution open to speculation. All windows and surface treatments appear fairly uniform, which only increases the puzzle.

The six-bay long by two bay deep north facade includes two cross-gables. A two-story one-bay section runs to the south, extending the roofline. All gables and bays on the north and east sides contain 2/2 sash windows except for the fifth bay on the north side, which contains a door. A pedimented porch shelters the door. Two central chimneys heat the main block, while a third chimney heats the south section. German siding covers the house.


