This multi-part frame house has as its central section a one and a half story two bay cross-gabled structure, presumably the oldest part of the complex. The entire building is covered with aluminum siding. Windows in the cross-gabled section have six over six pane sashes. There is one window in the first story front and another in the cross-gable. The main entrance is off-set toward the east end of the front elevation. Brick chimneys are located inside the end walls. Attached to each end of the house is an addition.




