This house is a two story, five bay frame structure with a central cross-gable. It has a modern two story addition and a garage attached to its east end. Windows have two over two pane sashes. There is a slightly smaller window of the same type in the cross-gable. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front or north elevation. A hip roofed porch extends across the front elevation. It is supported by turned posts with decorative scroll cut brackets. Interior brick chimneys project from the roof ridge approximately opposite the base of each side of the cross-gable.


