ADDENDUM

Section 3.

The current owners of the property at 2925 Honey Cove Court are Richard A. Blancato and Linda S. Blancato. Their mailing address is P.O. Box 1196, Prince Frederick, MD, 20678.

Section 4.

The property is identified in the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation as Tax Map 30, Parcel 200, Subdivision 226, Lot 3. The current deed to the property can be found in the land records of Calvert County in the Calvert County Courthouse in Prince Frederick: Deed Book ABE 639, Page 311.

Section 7.

The Barstow School was originally located on the west side of Hallowing Point Road in the small rural crossroads community of Barstow, north of Barstow Road. The building was moved circa 1900 to its current location in Honey Cove Estates, a new suburban residential development on the west bank of Battle Creek, southeast of the small rural community of Adelina. The school building is said to have been incorporated into the kitchen of the primary residence, constructed in 1982, on the site. The historic building has been altered beyond recognition in form, material, and plan.

Section 10.

The property consists of 5.0 acres located on the Broomes Island USGS quad map.


