## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Several sections form this five-bay by four-bay two-story frame farmhouse. The gable-roofed building is approximately "Z"-shaped. A two-bay eastern section of the south-facing facade projects one-bay deep. A two-bay ell runs north of the north side's west end. A turned-post porch covers the facade, including the projecting section, and the east side.

The facade's central entrance includes a door featuring an oval window, flanked by sidelights and topped by a transom. Two over two windows flanked by batten shutters light the house. Patterned metal shingles cover the roof.


