DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame house measures three bays wide across its cross-gabled east facade. A central entrance appears in the facade. A polygonal, tent-roofed tower covers the south gable end. A two-story ell extends to the rear.

Porches cross the facade, and the south side of the ell. Turned posts and scrollwork brackets distinguish the latter porch. Two over two windows light the house. One over one windows light the tower. Patterned shingles decorate the top section of the tower. An interior brick chimney heats the north end of the house.

Patterned metal shingles cover the roof. Asbestos shingles sheath the walls. The house stands on a brick foundation.




