DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame farmhouse measures three bays wide across the east-facing facade. A two-story shed-roofed addition crosses the rear, and a porch crosses the facade. Interior double brick chimneys heat the south end. The facade's northern entrance includes sidelights and a transom. The house features a side-hall double-parlor plan.

Six over six windows light the house. Brackets support the eaves. A standing-seam metal roof covers the house. Asbestos shingles sheathe the walls.

Several frame tobacco barns and a log outbuilding standing on brick piers are located behind the house.






