DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story, three-bay frame farmhouse includes a two-bay ell to the rear. The west-facing facade is covered by a porch with turned posts. The entrance appears in the facade's southernmost bay. An interior brick stove-flue chimney heats the north end.

Six over six windows light the house. Corrugated metal covers the roof, and aluminum siding sheathes the walls.






