Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

Located on the south side of MD 231/Church Street and just east of CT 818 is a 1 1/2 story steeply pitched, side gable house flanked by one story side gable additions. A front projecting gable pierces the front façade. Inside the front projecting gable is a band of 1/1 DHS windows and a semi-circular vent. The chimney is also placed on the front façade. Chimney placement on the front façade is reminiscent of the Tudor style and was carried over into the Minimal Traditional style. Nestled between the front projecting gable and the chimney is the front door. The roof is asphalt shingle and the house is clad in aluminum siding. There is a detached two-car garage to the southwest side of the property. Currently, the Vestry of St. Paul's owns the property and perhaps use it as the rectory.




