DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farm includes a two-story frame house, a wagon shed to the east, and a frame tobacco barn to the west.

The L-shaped house faces south. On the facade, the projecting ell measures two bays wide by one bay deep. The main block running perpendicularly behind the ell measures four bays long by a single bay deep. The entrance is located in the eastern section of the main block.

A porch featuring turned posts and jigsaw brackets covers the front, including the ell. Two brick stove-flue chimneys heat the center of the house.

Two over two windows flanked by louvered shutters light the house. Half-circle louvers vent the attic gables. Patterned tin shingles cover the roof. Narrow German siding sheathes the walls.


