Although plainly finished, this well-built farmhouse remains intact. It is slightly earlier in date than many of its type.

This two-story frame farmhouse measures three wide bays across its east-facing facade. A shuttered, arched window lights the cross-gable. A kitchen section extends to the rear. A hip-roofed porch crosses the facade and the south gable end. An interior brick chimney heats the north end, while an exterior brick chimney heats the south end.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame farmhouse measures three wide bays across its east-facing facade. A shuttered, arched window lights the cross-gable. A kitchen section extends to the rear. A hip-roofed porch crosses the facade and the south gable end. An interior brick chimney heats the north end, while an exterior brick chimney heats the south end.

Two over two windows flanked by louvered shutters light the house. Sidelights and a transom surround the central door. Square posts support the porch roof.

Corrugated metal covers the roof. Lapped weatherboards sheathe the walls.

A small frame outbuilding stands northwest of the house.


