DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The cross-gable on the east facade of this two-story frame farmhouse features a fine jigsawn bargeboard and finial. The three-bay facade includes a central entrance and a hip-roofed porch. An ell extends to the rear.

Six over six windows flanked by louvered shutters light the house. Sidelights and a transom surround the front door. An arched six over six window lights the cross-gable. Round tapered columns support the porch roof. An interior brick chimney heats either gable end. Asphalt shingles cover the roof, while asbestos shingles sheathe the walls.

A frame garage and a small frame outbuilding stand northwest of the house. Another small frame building of undetermined use is located northeast of the dwelling. The one-story structure's gable end faces the road to the east. A central door is flanked by a shuttered window to either side. German siding covers the building. A frame lean-to carport covers the north side.


