DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame farmhouse faces south. It includes a two-bay main section to the east, a one-bay addition to the west, and an ell to the north. Two over two windows light the house. Brick stove-flue chimneys heat the east end of the main house and the north end of the ell. The main section's entrance appears in the west bay. A simple portico shelters the door.

Patterned metal shingles cover the roof of the main section. The addition's roof is covered with standing seam metal. German siding sheathes the walls.





