This multi-part frame farmhouse comprises two main sections. A true 1½-story, three-bay-long section runs east-west, while a two-story, one-bay-square section forms an ell to the south. A shed-roofed porch fills the corner of the "L". A shed-roofed addition covers the 1½-story section's west end.

A gabled dormer lights the south side of the 1½-story section. A small cross-gable appears on the west roof slope of the second section. Six over six windows light both sections of the house.

Brick chimneys heat the shed addition, the center of the first section, and the northeast corner of the second section. Corrugated sheet metal covers the roof. Lapped weatherboards sheathe the walls.
