The central cross-gable on the west facade of this two-story frame farmhouse is echoed in the cross-gable of the shed-roofed porch. The two-bay building includes a two-story ell to the rear.

The entrance occupies the right-hand bay. Six over six windows light the first floor, while six over three windows light the second floor. A four-pane window set on the diagonal lights the steeply-pitched cross-gable.

German siding covers the house.


