**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The present appearance of this Patuxent Riverfront house is that of a 20th century Colonial Revival house. The two-story frame building includes a one-story kitchen section to the north followed by a perpendicular, one-story garage.

The main block measures three bays long by two bays deep. 6/6 shuttered windows light the second floor. Two 6-beside-6 casement windows light the first floor. An exterior brick chimney heats either gable end. A small lantern cupola straddles the roof.

The east gable end of the garage features a set of double doors, hinged at the sides, large enough to admit one car. The door head follows a shallow curved arch. Diagonal louvers fill the top half of the doors, while vertical boards fill the lower half. A four-pane casement window lights the gable attic. On the north side, a western entrance adjoins two 6/6 shuttered windows to the east. A shed dormer containing three four-pane casement windows lights the attic.

Wood shingles cover the roof.
