DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

C. 1870

This abandoned frame farmhouse perches on high land that rolls away to the Chesapeake Bay $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to the east. The main block, three bays long by one bay deep, rests on brick piers. It is covered with "German" siding. A common-bond exterior brick chimney rises from a stone base on the north end. It's upper, narrow flue above stepped shoulders is slightly detached from the wall. An interior stove flue heats the south end. A central entrance in the west facade leads to a stair hall.

A one bay-deep-by two-bay-wide two-story frame kitchen runs eastward from the north end of the east side. A stove flue serves the east end of the kitchen. A one-story shed-roofed frame addition completes the block in the southeast corner. All interior and exterior finishes in the house are extremely plain.

Two log outbuildings remain on the farm. One building (CT-693A) of undetermined use stands to the south of the main house. A log corncrib (CT-693B) is located along the driveway, southwest of the dwelling. Both buildings are constructed of V-notched, unchinked logs, originally whitewashed inside and out. They appear to have been re-roofed in the 20th century.


