This two story frame farmhouse features a central cross gable lit by a pointed-arch window. The north facade's central entrance is sheltered by a simple hood. The three bay facade is lit by six over six windows. A kitchen section extends to the rear.

An interior brick stove flue chimney heats either gable end. Tar paper covers the roof. Plain lapped weatherboards sheath the walls.

A small one story outbuilding stands northeast of the house. The north-facing building features a central board-and-batten door flanked by a six over six window to either side. An exterior brick stove flue chimney heats the east gable end.


