THREE GABLES VICTORIAN HOUSE

ca. 1880

One of the few Victorian Gothic inspired houses in Calvert County and one of the earliest homes now standing on Solomon's Island. It is a two story frame house, five bays in length at the principle facade with the central three bays covered by a simple pedimented porch with round tapered columns. At the roof level are three cross gables, each with a pointed arched window. The center window of the second level is covered by a hood supported by simple, machine cut brackets.

A peaked porch covers the central 3 bays on the first storey. The central window on the second storey has a small hood over it, held up by simple machine-cut brackets. The attractive and interesting feature of the house are the three large and steeply roofed gables which comprise the front of the roof. Each one of them contains a pointed arched window.</p> <p>Attractively situated on a large tree-filled lot, this house deserves mention as a very unusual structure in Calvert County.
