



This house faces northeast onto Maryland Route 765. It is a two-story double-pile, wood framed three-bay house with a side-passage-parlor plan. The gable roof is interrupted by a front-facing cross gable that is centered over the middle bay of the facade. The original weatherboarding has been replaced with asbestos shingles. The main doorway is sidelighted and transomed; the windows have original two-over-two double-hung sash. A polygonal bay has been built into the southeast gable end. This house is for sale.

Two over two windows framed in flat boards light the house. A round-arched window appears in the cross-gable.

Asphalt shingles cover the roof, and asbestos shingles cover the walls. The house stands on a rock-faced concrete block foundation.
