A single-pen log barn and a two-story frame farmhouse are the principal structures on this farm. The three-bay L-shaped dwelling faces south.

The barn's gable roof runs east-west. All sides but the north are covered by frame sheds. The round unchinked logs are joined by a v-notch.

This is one of the best-preserved log barns in Calvert County.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

A single-pen log barn and a two-story cross-gabled frame farmhouse are the principal structures on this farm. The three-bay L-shaped dwelling faces south. The entrance appears to the east. A screened porch protects the facade.

Two over two windows light the house. Brick chimneys heat the west end and the ell. Asbestos shingles cover the walls.

The barn's gable roof runs east-west. All sides but the north are covered by frame sheds. The round unchinked logs are joined by a v-notch.

A short door opening appears on the north side. Corrugated sheet metal covers the roof and vertical boards sheathe the walls.
