This house has been heavily altered, but its form suggests that it was built in the nineteenth century. It faces east onto Old Town Road. The original section is a two-story framed and weatherboarded structure with a plan of 3:2 proportions. It is double pile with a gable roof. The original facade has been entirely obscured by a new bay window and by a modern offset enclosed porch. The six-over-six sash are modern. The brick chimney on the south gable end is also new. A one-story wing has been added to the north gable end, and the entire structure has been sheathed with vinyl siding.




