It is built of wood framing and sheathed with beveled weatherboards. There is a hipped asphalt shingle roof. The double-door entrance is flanked by new single-pane windows. An original sash on the back of the structure is two-over-two double-hung. On the side walls, false corner boards suggest that the building has been extended forward. If that is the case, then the hipped roof is also an addition.




