The house faces east at the southwest corner of Maryland Route 2/4 and Stoakley Road. It is a three-bay turn-of-the-century I-house, framed and weathboarded. The gable roof is covered with decoratively molded sheet metal. A front-facing gable centered over the main entrance has a rounded-headed window in it. The original two-over-two double-hung sash have been replaced in some places with six-over-six windows. There are ridgeline brick chimneys that are built along the interior partition walls. A two-story one-bay rear ell is extended by a one-story one-bay ell and two or three shed additions. There is a one-story hipped-roof porch sheltering the facade. It has turned posts but not surviving brackets. Part of it is screened in. There is a front-facing pediment on the front porch located over the central bay. A contemporary barn and several vertical-boarded outbuildings are sited around the house.

C. 1900

This standard cross-gable farmhouse stands on the old "Stoakley" land grant. The farm's most interesting structure is a small log outbuilding standing southwest of the dwelling. A barn and several small sheds complete the farm.

The two-story frame house includes a two-story kitchen section to the west, and a one-story addition filling the "L" in the northwest corner. 2/2 sash light the one bay by three bay house. A stove flue appears to either side of the cross-gable, and one heats the kitchen's west end. A cross-gabled porch shelters the east facade.
