This complex consists of 17 one-story, rectangular, brick-faced, gable-roofed frame houses, built in 1947, that serve as Married Enlisted Men's Quarters. Buildings 6200-6216 do not demonstrate the architectural distinction or important historical associations necessary to meet National Register criteria of historic significance. These Married Enlisted Men's Quarters buildings are ordinary examples of postwar military housing, and the complex of 17 buildings does not represent a noteworthy instance of planning for a military residential facility.

**SUMMARY:** This complex consists of 17 one-story, rectangular, gable-roofed frame houses, built in 1947, that serve as Married Enlisted Men's Quarters.

**GENERAL DESCRIPTION:** These 17 Married Enlisted Men's Quarters buildings were constructed in 1947. They are all one-story, rectangular, gable-roofed frame structures built on poured-concrete foundations, clad in stretcher bond brick masonry, and roofed with asphalt shingle. Some of the buildings have their gable ends filled with vinyl siding, some with brick. Each building is approximately 40x24 feet. The fenestration is asymmetrical in pattern. The window sash is of the one-over-one double-hung wooden type. Some sense of architectural variety was given to the complex by varying the porch configuration for the houses, some porches extending fully across the principal facade, some partially, and others situated against the gable end. The gable-end porches form the porch roof by extending the roof beyond the end of the building. The majority of buildings have shed-roofed porches against the principal facade. All of the porches appear to represent a comprehensive alteration made to the complex at some date. The interiors are of very plain finish, e.g., linoleum strips serve in place of baseboard.

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
