Quarters BB, constructed circa 1930, is a one-story, front-gabled vernacular bungalow of frame construction. The associated garage was evidently built after 1950. Quarters BB does not demonstrate the architectural distinction or important historical associations necessary to meet National Register criteria of historic significance. The house is unexceptional either as an example of a vernacular interpretation of the bungalow form, or as an example of the military adaptation of preexisting dwellings as officers' quarters.

SUMMARY: Quarters BB, constructed circa 1930, is a one-story, front-gabled vernacular bungalow of frame construction. There is a garage evidently built after 1950.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: Quarters BB is set on its own lot situated by a cove of the Patuxent River, with a sense of seclusion conferred by the mature shade trees that encompass the house and its yard. The house, built circa 1930, is a one-story, rectangular, front-gabled frame structure that is representative of a vernacular rendition of the bungalow form. It is clad in asbestos shingle and roofed with asphalt shingle. The window sash is of the three-over-one double-hung wooden type. Enclosed porches extend across both the front (northeast) and rear end elevations. A brick chimney rises in an exterior side position at about the center of the southeast wall.

The house is accompanied by a single-bay, frame garage building that stands about 40 feet to the northeast. This garage appears to be less than 50 years old.

SUMMARY: Quarters BB does not demonstrate the architectural distinction or important historical associations necessary to meet National Register criteria of historic significance. The house is unexceptional either as an example of a vernacular interpretation of the bungalow form or as an example of the military adaptation of preexisting dwellings as officers' quarters.

GENERAL NARRATIVE: Quarters BB was constructed circa 1930 for J. C. Webster, then the owner-resident on this property. Whether this house was Webster's residence or a tenant dwelling is not known. In 1942 Webster's 168-acre tract was condemned for the Naval Mine Warfare Test Center, and the house was soon afterward adapted by the Navy for use as a Married Officers' Quarters cottage. The garage was evidently built by the Navy, probably during the period 1960-1980.


