





This side-gable bungalow faces northeast onto Maryland Route 765. For its near center-of-town location, it is in remarkably original condition. Set on a decoratively molded concrete-block foundation, it is a one-and-a-half-story, framed and weatherboarded, gable-roofed dwelling with an interior gable-end brick chimney and a front-facing, three-bay gable-roofed dormer. The facade has three bays: a side entrance, and two sets of paired windows. The asphalt-shingled roof extends far enough to shelter a rear shed extension and a front porch. The deep eaves are decorated with sawn corbeled brackets. The porch is supported by tapering piers set on molded concrete-block bases.


