This early twentieth-century Colonial Revival house faces west onto Maryland Route 765. It is a two-story framed and weather-boarded structure, but the second story is illuminated with broad and deep shed dormers in a way that makes the house look like it is only one and a half stories high. The house is two rooms deep and has six-over-one-double-hung-sash windows. The gable roof kicks out in front to shelter a porch that is screened and thus obscures the entire first-story facade. The second-story facade, however, is three bays wide. There is a modern rear deck built onto the back of the house.




PRINCE FREDERICK


