This house is sited in what is now an open, overgrown field. It faces north. It is a two-story single-pile three-bay framed and weatherboarded house with a gable roof and a two-room plan. There is one exterior brick chimney built onto the east gable end. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles. A one-story hipped-roof porch shelters three sides of the house. The structure is attached at the rear to a one-story two-room-plan gable-roofed structure with an interior brick stove flue. All windows have two-over-two double-hung sash. The house has been abandoned.






