This early twentieth-century side-gable bungalow faces east onto Maryland Route 2/4. Set on a concrete-block foundation, it is a framed and weatherboarded, one-and-a-half-story structure. The facade is concealed behind an enclosed shed-roofed porch. There is an exterior brick chimney and a one-story polygonal bay on the south gable-end wall. The upper story is illuminated by a gabled three-bay dormer. The windows are glazed with two-over-two double-hung sash.


