Description of Property and Justification: *(Please attach map and photo)*

The north annex of the Calvert Marine Museum is a ca. 1940s Colonial Revival style house, now used as part of the Calvert Marine Museum. The 2-story, 3-bay x 2-bay, frame dwelling is set on the east side of Solomons Island Road. The house retains wood siding and has a wood shingle side gable roof. The primary façade is symmetrical. A six-panel main entry door is framed by sidelights and covered by an entry portico, with a curved underside, supported by slender columns. The house has one-over-one windows, which are paired on the 1st floor. An exterior brick fireplace chimney is centered on the south gable end and a 1-story hipped-roof sunporch extends across the south elevation. Recent unpainted wood steps are located on the rear elevation, providing egress from both the 1st and 2nd floors.

Based on preliminary research, the north annex of the Calvert Marine Museum is not associated with events and trends that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history, disqualifying it for eligibility under Criterion A. The property is not associated with any person or group of persons of outstanding importance to the community, state, or nation, disqualifying the property under Criterion B. While the north annex of the Calvert Marine Museum is representative of the Colonial Revival, it is not an exceptional example and does not represent the work of a master or possess high artistic merit. Thus the property is not eligible under Criterion C. The north annex of the Calvert Marine Museum is recommended not eligible for the National Register





Prepare both a summary paragraph and a general description of the resource and its various elements as it exists today.

This house faces west onto Solomons Island Road. It is set on a molded concrete foundation. It is a two-story double-pile, three-bay gable-roofed framed and weatherboarded early twentieth-century example of the Colonial Revival style. There is an exterior brick chimney on the south gable end and a one-story hipped wing added to the same side of the house. The central side-lighted entrance is flanked by pairs of windows with one-over-one double-hung sash replacing the original six-over-six design. The entrance is sheltered by an arched and pedimented stoop supported on thick Doric columns.


