This turn-of-the-century house faces north onto C Street. Like the house to the east (CT-920), it is a two-story framed and weatherboarded gable-roofed dwelling oriented with its gable end toward the front. It has a two-bay facade and is two rooms deep. There is a central brick chimney. The windows have two-over-two double-hung sash. This house differs from the one next door in that there is a two-story original cross wing built onto the east side of the house. A hipped-roof one-story porch shelters the north and east sides of the house. This porch has recently been enclosed. The original siding has also been replaced with aluminum weatherboards.

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
